

### In case of ACCIDENT...

- Stop the vehicle at once.
- Render all possible aid to the injured.
- Notify the nearest police officer, sheriff or Highway Patrol officer.
- Get the driver's name, residence, including city and street number, motor vehicle number and classification, or operator's number. Give the same information to him about yourself.
- If the accident involves a parked car or other property and you do not locate the owner, leave your name and address on the damaged property where the owner will find it and report the matter to the nearest enforcement authorities.
- If the accident results in death or personal injury, or property damage exceeding \$100 or any other accident, file a "Statement of Facts" with the Missouri Department of Transportation.
- Report forms may be obtained from the Highway Patrol or from any office of the Department of Revenue.

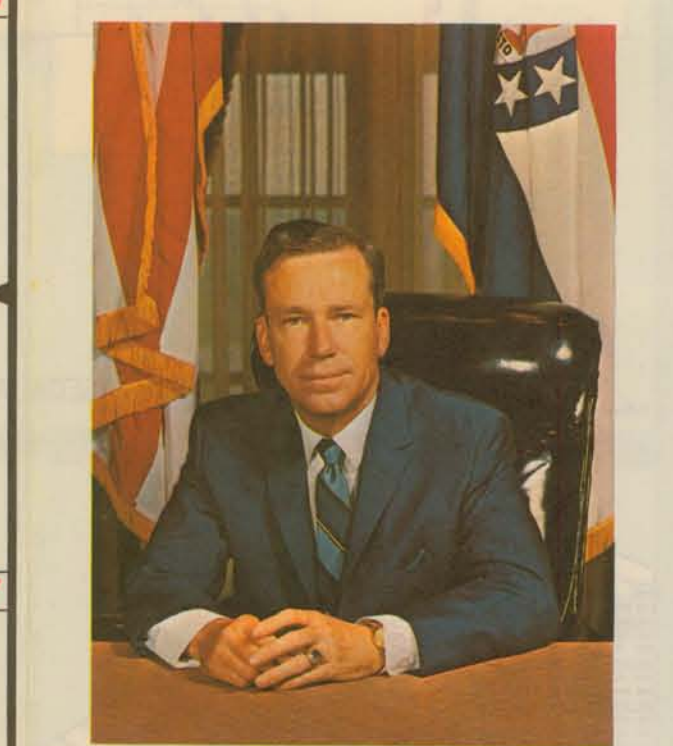
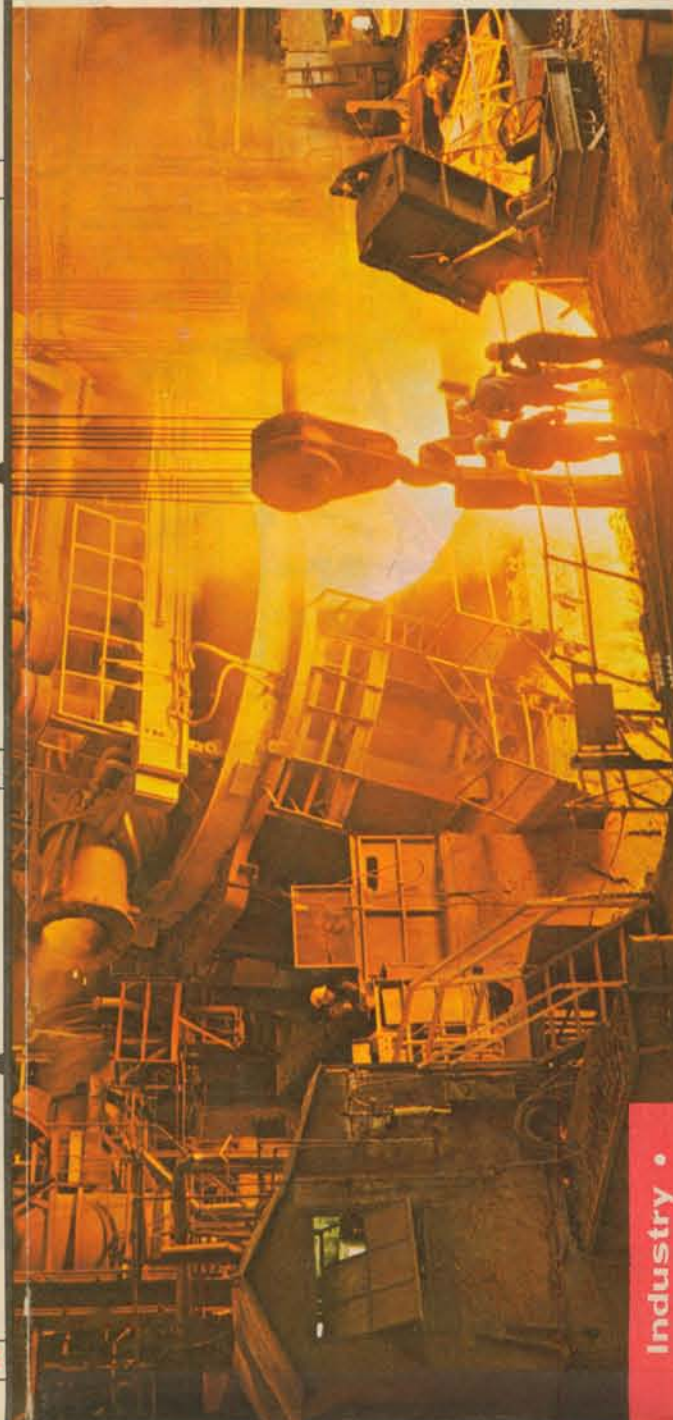
