**Giving You the Driving Edge**  
 The Missouri Department of Transportation offers a variety of tools to help you get where you're going quickly and safely.

- 24/7 Customer Service - MoDOT's toll-free telephone number - 888-ASK-MODOT (275-6636) - is answered by a live person 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- Online Traveler Information Map - MoDOT's Traveler Information Map, located at [www.modot.org](http://www.modot.org), gives you the latest information on road conditions and work zones.
- Electronic Message Boards - MoDOT has installed 60 electronic message boards along interstates that give information on road conditions, closings and construction.
- Emergency Reference Markers - Located every two-tenths of a mile on Missouri interstates, these signs help pinpoint your exact location in case of an emergency.



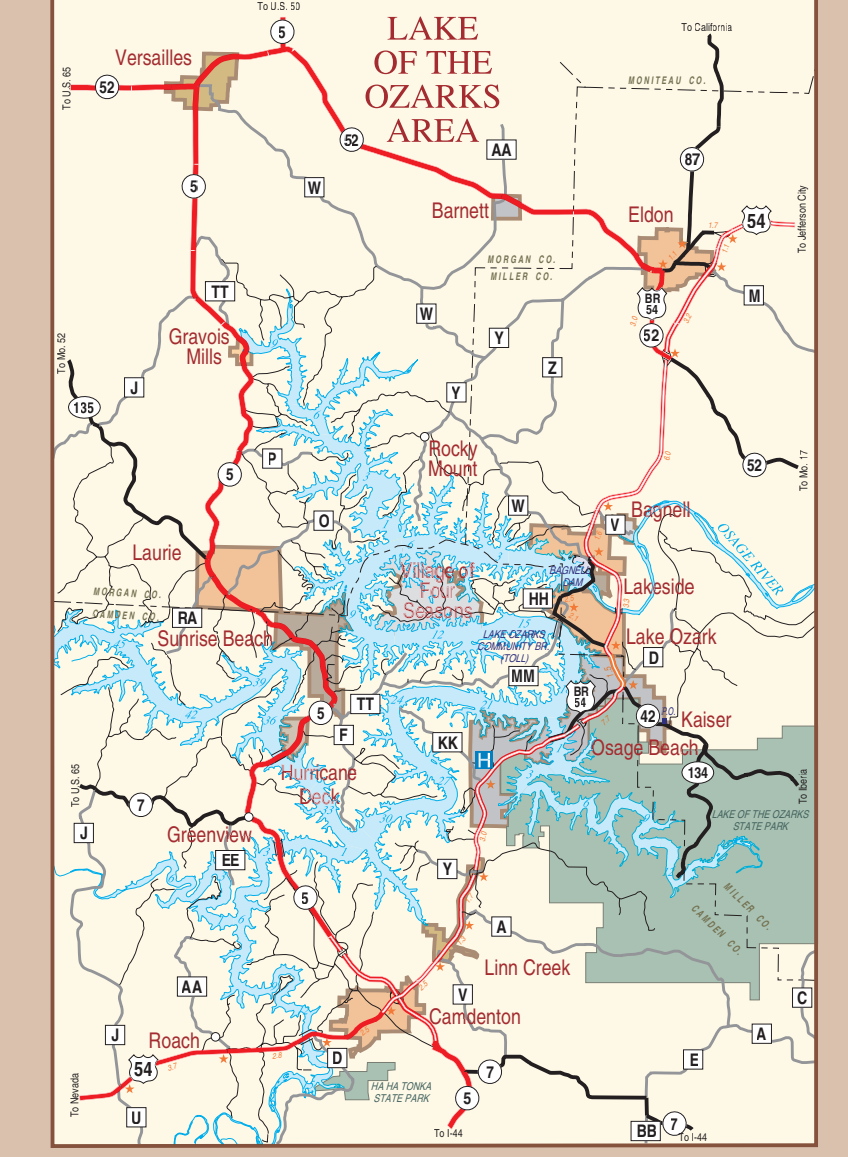
**Rules of the Road**  
 Traffic laws vary from state to state. Here are some Missouri rules you should know.

- Missouri law requires drivers to wear their seat belts.
- Missouri law requires drivers to slow down (when safe to do so) when approaching emergency vehicles working on the highways.
- If you're involved in a minor, non-injury traffic accident, state law requires you to move your vehicle off the road to keep traffic from backing up.
- Children under eight years of age must travel in an appropriate child safety seat or booster seat unless they weigh 80 pounds or are 4 feet, 9 inches tall.
- Headlights must be used in foggy weather and whenever weather conditions require drivers to use their windshield wipers.
- Hitting a highway worker with your vehicle could cost \$10,000, as well as a lost license for a year.

**Improving Roads and Bridges, Saving Lives**

- Thanks to Missourians' recent investments in the state's transportation system, 83 percent of the state's highways are in good condition.
- Recent highway improvements, along with education and law enforcement efforts by the Missouri State Highway Patrol and other safety partners, have led to a dramatic 24 percent decrease in traffic fatalities in the last three years.
- Missouri is focusing its attention on fixing its bridges. Through the Safe & Sound Bridge Improvement Program - the largest bridge program in state history - MoDOT will repair or replace 802 of Missouri's worst bridges in five years. The bridges to be improved are marked with a sign bearing the Safe & Sound logo.
